She plans to give EGC members an opportunity to sponsor plant purchases and will give a presentation at the upcoming general meeting on October 7, 2024.

<u>Website Maintenance and Updates</u>: Website maintenance and updates were discussed. Nancy H., Nancy M, and Gayle will work on ensuring new members are added to the club roster and are included in Trumpetvine emails. <u>Upcoming Plant Exchange</u>: The upcoming general meeting on October 7, 2024 will include a plant exchange. Set up and clean up duties were arranged among the board.

<u>Proposed Greens Party with Master Gardeners</u>: A motion was approved to hold the EGC's annual Greens Party along with the Master Gardeners. This event is scheduled for Wednesday, December 4, 2024 at the Benton County Fairgrounds. More information to follow as details are arranged.

<u>Fundraising and Raffle</u>: The board discussed possible fundraising and raffle ideas. This is on-going among the Fundraising Committee.

<u>NPK Kiosk</u>: In collaboration with other groups, the EGC prepares a flyer once per month to display in NPK boxes throughout the city. The need for volunteers will be brought up at the upcoming general meeting on October 7, 2024.

<u>Membership</u>: There are currently 174 EGC members.
